


How to update the IP address on local host folder:

You must have admin rights on your computer to make this change on your individual computer or share this document with your IT department to implement the change for your site/company.

1. Navigate to the path: c:/windows/system32/drivers/etc folder
2. Edit the file called 'hosts'.
3. Add the following line to the bottom of the data in the file (screenshot is below).
4. 74.116.10.108 adfsi3.molinahealthcare.com
5. Then save the file
6. Close web browser, reopen, and try to open website again.
